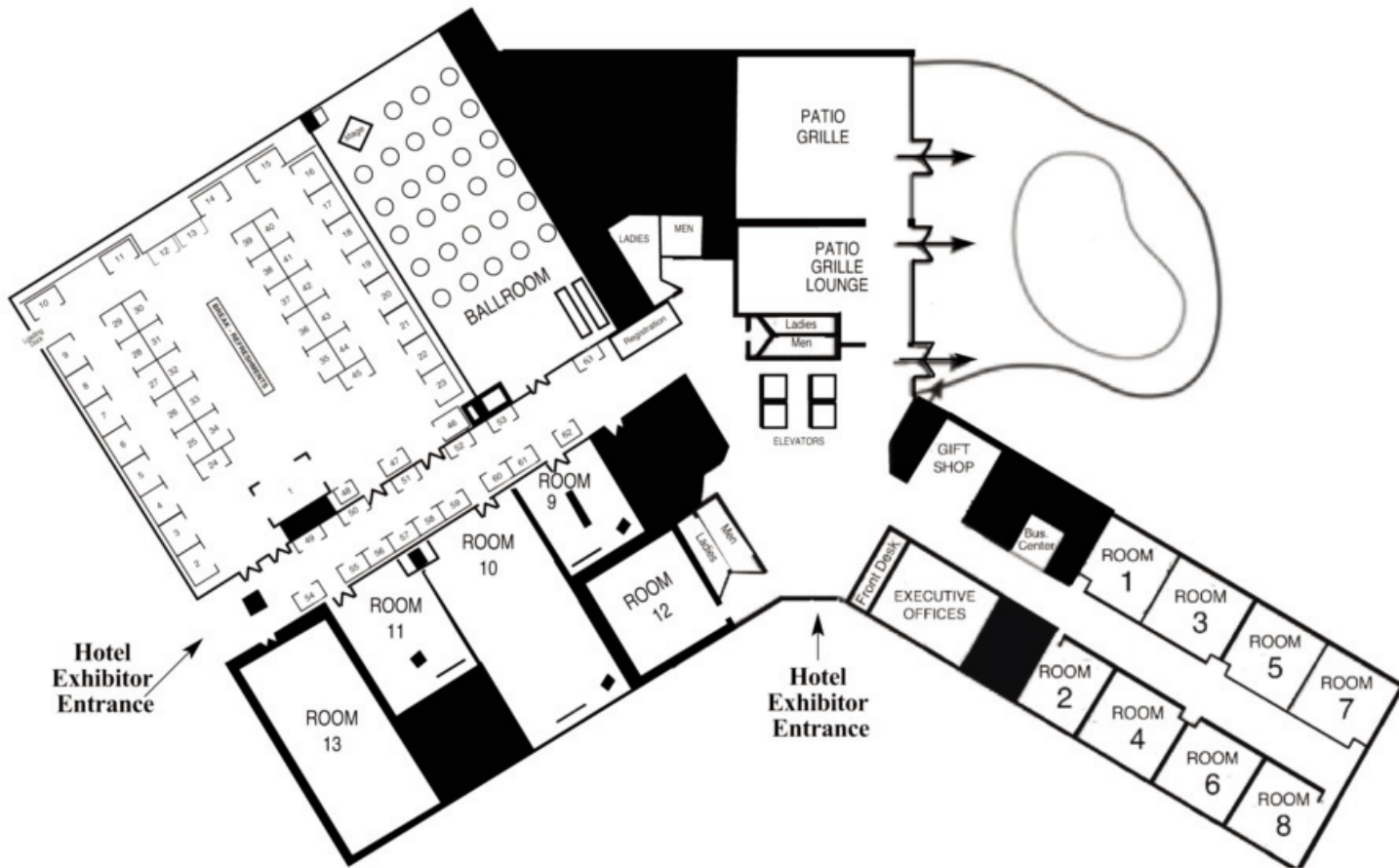

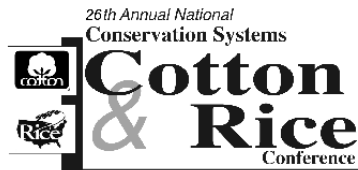

PESTICIDE RECERTIFICATION CREDITS

We have not received approval at time of printing, but this is what we have been approved for in the past. We Expect to Have Approval - for attendees from the following states.

► Louisiana

The National Conservation Systems Cotton & Rice Conference is approved for recertification credit for Louisiana Commercial Pesticide Applicators Holding Certification in General Standards (GS), Agricultural Pest Control (1), and Demonstration and Research Pest Control (10).

► Mississippi

The National Conservation Systems Cotton & Rice Conference was approved by the Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce for individuals attending this conference seeking recertification credit for Category Ia: Agricultural Pest Control Plant, Category X: Demonstration and Research Pest Control, Consultants License Renewal, Entomology, Plant Pathology, Weed Control.
